### Spain



Spain has traditionally meant Rioja, however other regions of the country are producing some exciting wines and Harveys have sourced some wines from Conca de Barbera, Ribera del Duero, Priorat and Toro. We are delighted to be partnering Valduero, Clos Galena and Clos Mont Blanc. These wineries are producing some great value Spanish wines giving a real taste of the country. Come and discover some real gems.

**Valduero** is a family run winery relatively new in wine terms, only started in 1984 by the Garcia Viadero family. Since then they have produced consistently high quality wines, amongst the best in the region which is known for Spains most expensive wine, Vega Sicilia and Pingus. Whilst Spain has a very hot climate the height of the vineyards (840 mtr above sea level) gives cold night time climates.

# Clos Mont Blanc

A cooperative until 1988 when the Carbonell Figueras family became the owners, this winery is producing some very exciting ranges and is experimenting with a wide variety of grapes. The wines are produced around the town of Mont Blanc with their prize vineyard, Masia las Comes, situated in the hills around 20 kilometres away. Wines especially to look for are the Pinot Noir giving great weight and flavour, Syrah which is drinking well and the Masia Las Comes wine which needs time to soften.

The wines they produce are very traditional in style and give fruits of the forest notes and subtle oak nuances. The region also has 2 wines from the Rincon da Navas vineyard owned by another of Harveys partners, Valduero

## Italy

Italy is a country that offers some fantastic wines and variety from the North to the South of the country. Harveys are striving to offer an exciting range of wines from Italy working with great partners to give plenty of choice and flavour. Pio Cesare are one of the finest producers of Piedmont wines and these are backed up with some great wines from Monferrato. Fabiano are a long established winery in Verona making some quality Valpolicella and Amarone wines. Recent additions include some great Tuscan wines from Donatello Colombini and Trasqua as well as some exciting white wines from Cantine Marzo.



Fabiano own many vineyards producing great wines from the Veneto region. Vini Fabiano was founded in 1912 in a shop in Venice, today the family own vineyards in Valpolicella and Lugana producing some excellent styles from North East Italy

**Vajo Veronese IGT (Corvina, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon) Fabiano £21.91**

This wine is a full flavoured wine with ripe red fruit and delicately spiced notes, the palate lingers with fine and lasting tannins. It will accompany many red meat dishes or strong cheeses. Ideal to open the bottle a few hours before serving

**Amarone I Fondatori Fabiano £35.49**

Only 6000 bottles are produced from hand picked grapes from a classic area of Valpolicella. Well rounded with raisined fruit notes and a complex and beautifully balanced flavour.

**Amarone Storica Fabiano £24.49**

**Valpolicella Ripasso Fabiano £11.81**

This wine receives a second fermentation (ripasso) in March, on the still warm and rich sugary residue grapes of Amarone. This gives the wine extra bouquet, structure and complexity.

**Valpolicella Recioto Fabiano £18.99**

This lovely dessert wine has concentrated blackcurrant flavours and a beautifully balanced smooth flavour.

**Bardolino Damiani £6.49**

**Lugana Fondatori Argillaia Fabiano £11.99**

An amazing lesser known wine from the Veneto region, this has a full flavour with buttery and mouth watering fruit flavours. Well worth trying something different, this will accompany salmon or cream cheese.

Only produced in top vintages the name "Il Bricco" means the peak of a hill, this estate overlooks the village of Treiso.

Produced in the best vintage this is a lovely rich and complex wine.

**Barolo:** A true gem with 70% of the wine coming from family-owned vineyards around Serralunga A host of notes including dried fruits, cedar, mulberry and truffle, this is another excellent wine with game. £35.62

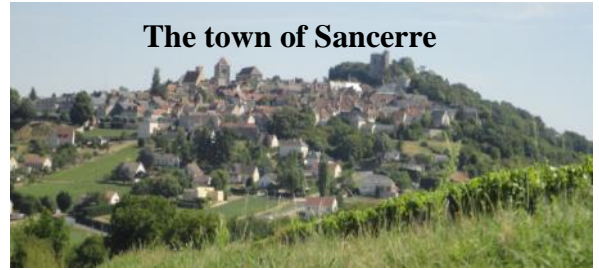

## French Southern Regional

Southern France offers some great complex wines in a more traditional style and Harveys have sought to offer a good variety of styles and flavours. Recent additions include a fine selection from Domaine L'ille in Corbières and some new Costières de Nimes wines. Little known but offering some lovely full flavoured wines are the pair from Limoux.

### White

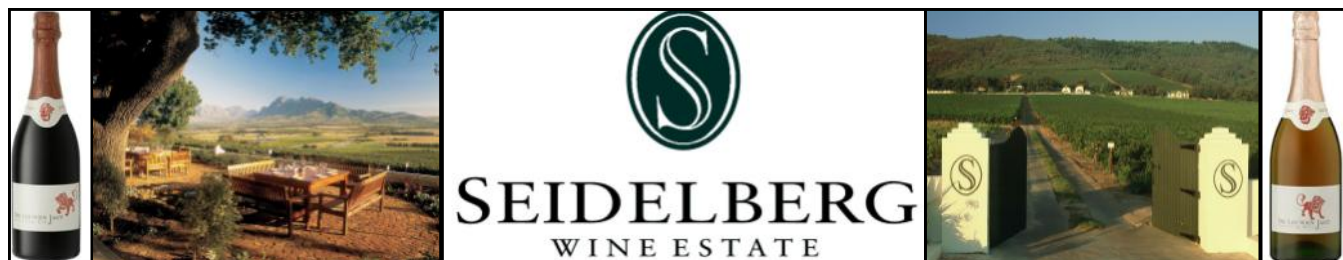

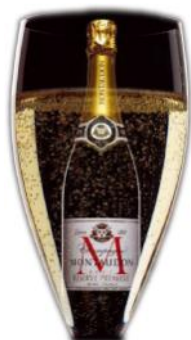
