Built in the 18th century as a Georgian residence, the Bridge Inn famously housed King Louis Philippe of France after he fled during the revolution.

Having been closed since purchase due to unforeseen restrictions, this site is currently under renovation to a high standard and the reopening will be greatly anticipated by the local community and surrounding visitors.

Location

Situated in a prominent position within Newhaven Town Centre and visible from the one-way system, the busy port and train station are within a couple of minutes' walk with main bus routes close by.

The town of Newhaven is currently undergoing a regeneration scheme and local authorities are investing in many local projects and housing.

Accommodation

Primarily a wet led venue with approx.. 60 covers plus an additional outside seating space. There will be a small prep kitchen with potential for an electric set-up, or "prepared off site" operation.
